
quitSaveDefault-package
Default Quit Save Action

Description

Allows the action taken by `quit(save="default")` to be queried and changed. People who don't like polluting their shell with aliases may wish to add `quit.save.default("no")` to their `~/.Rprofile`. Yes, this is clearly excessive, but hopefully someone will add an option to R or something.

Usage

```
quit.save.default(value = NULL)
```

Arguments

`value` the (character) default save action as passed to `quit`, one of "no", "yes", or "ask". NULL (the default) means not to change it.

When the package loads, it will automatically call `quit.save.default(getOption("quit.save.default"))` if that option is set.

Value

`quit.save.default` returns the current default save action.
