## Description

Allows the action taken by `quit(save="default")` to be queried and changed. People who don't like polluting their shell with aliases may wish to add `quit.save.default("no")` to their '`.Rprofile`'. Yes, this is clearly excessive, but hopefully someone will add an option to R or something.

## Usage

```
quit.save.default(value = NULL)
```

## Arguments

<code>value</code>	the (character) default save action as passed to <code>quit</code> , one of "no", "yes", or "ask". <code>NULL</code> (the default) means not to change it.

## Details

When the package loads, it will automatically call `quit.save.defaultgetOption("quit.save.default")` if that option is set.

## Value

`quit.save.default` returns the current default save action.
